En Inglés usamos el pasado del verbo to be para expresar donde "estábamos" o que "estábamos haciendo". Example: "I was at my grandma's house yesterday". O "She was writing an essay last night".

Usamos el auxiliar "was or were" que es el pasado del verbo "to be" que conocemos am, is o are.

Cuando mencionamos que alguien nació en algún lugar o en alguna fecha, usamos el pasado "was born", "My sister was born in Catamarca last month".






